

Stock Category - Non-Modified Cars

Engine & Transmission

1. No modifications or upgrades to the engine or its components are allowed, even if factory-approved.
2. No modifications or upgrades to the transmission are allowed.
3. Adding an oil cooler for the engine or transmission is not allowed.

Vehicle Body

1. Replacing or lightening any type of vehicle glass is not allowed.
2. Replacing or lightening any part of the vehicle is not allowed.

Interior

1. Removing seats is not allowed.
2. Lightening or removing any interior parts of the vehicle is not allowed.

Suspension

1. Modifying or upgrading the vehicle's suspension is not allowed.
2. Only the measurements listed on the vehicle's identification plate with the chassis number are allowed.

Differential, Axles & Driveshaft

Modifications or upgrades are not allowed.

Fuel

Only station fuel is allowed.

Notes

Programming is allowed only on the factory computer (the dealer is not responsible for warranty coverage).

(N/A Category)

Engine & Transmission

1. Modifications or upgrades to the engine block and cylinder head are allowed if they are factory components—AFTERMARKET parts are not allowed.
2. High-performance components from reputable manufacturers are allowed (internal parts, block, and cylinder head).
3. The entire exhaust system may be replaced.
4. Air filter modifications and replacements are allowed, but the filter must remain within the engine cover.

Vehicle Body

Lightening is not allowed.

Interior

1. Removing seats is not allowed.
2. Removing any interior trim components is not allowed.
3. Removing interior upholstery is not allowed.

Suspension

Upgrading or replacing the suspension is allowed as long as the mounting points are not modified.

Wheels & Tires

1. Any size may be used.
2. Slick (SLICK) and Skinny (SKINNY) tires are not allowed.

Differential, Axles & Driveshaft

Modifications or upgrades are not allowed.

Fuel

Only station fuel is allowed.

Power Added Category

Engine & Transmission

1. Modifications and upgrades to the engine block and cylinder head are allowed.
2. High-performance components from reputable manufacturers are allowed.
3. AFTERMARKET engine block replacements are allowed.
4. AFTERMARKET cylinder head replacements are allowed.
5. The entire exhaust system may be replaced.
6. Air filter modifications and replacements are allowed, with the option to add one power-enhancing system (Turbocharger – Supercharger – Nitrous).

Vehicle Body

1. Fiberglass and carbon fiber are allowed for the following parts:
 - Front bumper
 - Rear bumper
 - Front fenders
 - Hood
2. Lightening or replacing vehicle glass is allowed.

Interior

1. Seats may be removed.
2. Interior trim components may be removed.

Suspension

1. Suspension replacement and upgrades are allowed.
2. Modifications to mounting points are allowed.

Wheels & Tires

1. Any size may be used.
2. Slick (SLICK) and Skinny (SKINNY) tires are allowed.

Differential, Axles & Driveshaft

Modifications and upgrades are allowed.

Fuel

Any type of fuel is allowed except for nitromethane.

General Regulations

1. The entire front windshield must be intact, with only the officially approved tint level permitted by authorities.
 2. Seat belts must be worn at all times during the race and should not be removed until the race ends and the vehicle comes to a complete stop.
 3. Helmets must be worn at all times when the vehicle is on the track—from before the starting line until exiting the circuit.
 4. The permitted fuel for all categories is station fuel, with a maximum of 98 octane. The Power Added category may use any fuel except nitromethane, which is prohibited.
 5. Competitors in non-Power Added categories must wear a helmet and shoes (sportswear is optional).
 - Power Added category competitors must wear a race suit, helmet, and racing shoes.
 6. Participants must follow race official instructions before starting.
 7. Only factory-installed ECUs are allowed in the Stock category.
 8. Programming is permitted in all Stock categories, but only using factory-approved ECUs.
 9. The dealer (Bin Hamoodah Auto) is not responsible for warranty coverage, as tuned vehicles are not covered under warranty.
 10. Faisal Hassan Al Ali has been appointed as the head of technical inspection and race results committee, with Zayed Al Hosani overseeing organization.
 11. Driver substitution after inspection and registration is not allowed.
- A driver cannot participate in the same category with multiple cars.
 - A driver may participate in different categories with different vehicles.
 - Each competitor is allowed two attempts, with the best recorded speed counted.
